Drak Transmitter

I came across an article in RC Groups on the Drak video transmitter sold by RC Buddy. It is a very nice looking transmitter with an aluminum case. It weighs 12.3 grams without the antenna.



The Drak

The Drak has opening on the backsides of the case for cooling. Input voltage can be from 5v to 20v. The output voltage is from 5v to 19v. This means you can use 2s to 4s lipo batteries for power.



The Drak with the Monopole

The Drak comes with a monopole antenna which is a linear-polarized antenna, but I did replace it with the recommended IBCrazy race antenna. This is a much tougher antenna. IBCrazy also makes an omni directional whip antenna which is also a recommended antenna for use with the Drak. The IBCrazy race antenna is a circular-polarized antenna.

Drak with the IBCrazy Race Antenna

A great feature of the Drak is the adjustable power output from 25, 200, and 600mW. Fly greater distances away with 200 and 600 mW. Don't interfere with your racing buddies by using 25 mW.

With February having a limited number of good days to fly and a limited number of flyers I thought I would look back at our aircraft. These pictures go back to 2012.
































































