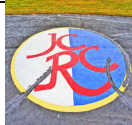

Rest in Peace Roy Davidson

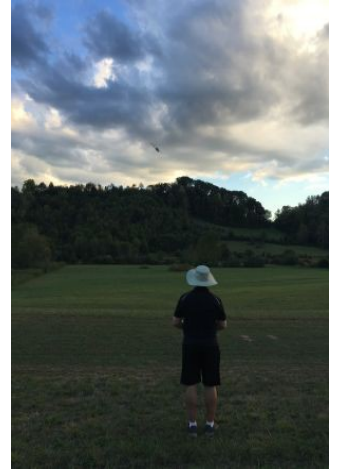

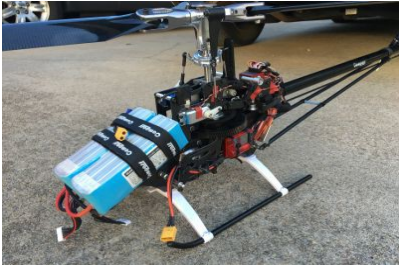
