President's Report

Club!

As my final note I wanted to cover some important events that affect us as hobbyists and model aircraft flyers. At this time it seems imminent that Congress will allow the FAA to re-enact their registration rule. That mostly means (if it IS passed) that we'll be required by the FAA to have an FAA registration number inside our models if they weigh over nine ounces (0.55 pounds.) (My Night Vapor it safe! Woo hoo.) So if you have previously registered, be ready to dig up that number and re-label your planes.

Regardless of what happens, my policy as club President is that the club will not be the police force for the FAA. In other words, we're an AMA club and as such all that the club is required to do is to follow AMA guidelines. We will not collect FAA numbers, driver's license numbers, social security numbers or any other non-AMA number. It's up to each individual to follow legally binding governmental regulations. The AMA itself will not require UAS registration for membership.

For clarification, I'd recommend that everyone read the two rules which currently govern the hobby. If you're an AMA member, Section 336, the Special Rule for Model Aircraft (in conjunction with AMA rules) governs our flying:

If you're not AMA or if you're flying outside of the AMA guidelines then you fall under the severe restrictions of 14 CFR 107:
