
## Next Meeting

## FYI –

In June, the AMA finally provided information on the FAA’s Recreational Pilot Safety Test. Called TRUST (The Recreational UAS Safety Test).

AMA is one of a number of organizations and companies administering the test. AMA’s test is on line at their website now. It is 23 questions, multiple choice, with no ability to complete the test without selecting the correct answer for each question. That is to say, if you pick the wrong answer for a question, you cannot go to the next question till you select the correct answer for the question you are on. It is structured as a tested training exercise. That is, there is a block of training, followed by several questions on that area. Each block must be completed before being able to move to the next block. The test will take as long as it takes for you to read each screen, and then move to the next screen until you have gone through the entire training session. The test is FREE. If you go to a site and are asked to pay, then it may not be the official test, beware...DO NOT PAY TO TAKE THE TEST!!!

When you complete the test you are taken to a page to enter your name and generate the certificate. YOU MUST either print out, save electronically via .pdf download or capture the generated certificate as an image. FAA requires you be able to provide proof that you passed the test upon request by FAA, Law Enforcement or other authorized entities. The certificate is a two page 8 & 1/2 by 11 inch printout.
