Incorporation of the Club

The following is a summary of what was presented to the club by Nick at the last meeting. The club voted to proceed with the process. The lawyer has volunteered his time to assist with the filling of the paperwork.

First, the board is to meet with Chad Whitfield. In this meeting they will prepare the charter for the new corporation.

Second, the charter will be submitted for approval. This cost will be \$100 paid to Washington county and \$7.00 to the State of Tennessee.

Third the club will file for tax exemption, both with the State and with the IRS. The fee will be \$250 for IRS and \$25 to \$50 for the State.

The time to completion will be about 12 months. The tax exemption will be retroactive to charter submittal date. The total fees will be approximately \$400.
