Sportsman Pattern Maneuvers.

1. Takeoff (U) K=1
2. Straight Flight Out (U) K=1
3. Half Reverse Cuban Eight K=1
4. Straight Flight Back (D) K=1
5. Half Cuban Eight K=1

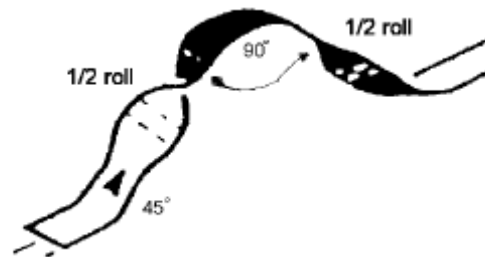
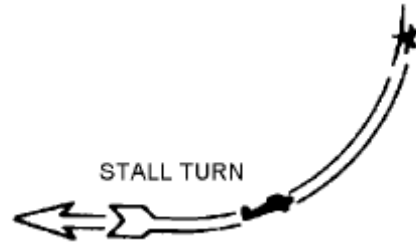
- 6. Two (2) Inside Loops (U) (Exit Box) K=2
- 7. Two (2) Point Roll (D) K=2
- 8. Stall Turn without Rolls K=2
- 9. Cobra without Rolls (U) K=1
- 10. Immelmann Turn K=2
- 11. One Horizontal Roll (D) K=1
- 12. Split "S" K=1
- 13. Double Immelmann without Rolls (U) K=2
- 14. Landing K=1
- Total K=19

Note: (U) means upwind; (D) means downwind.

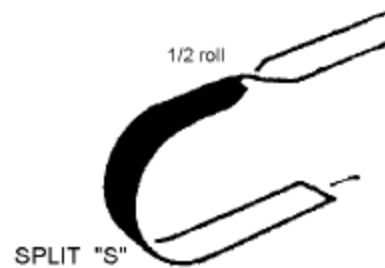
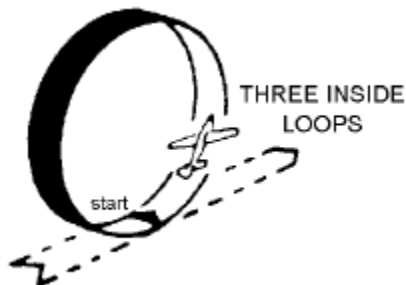
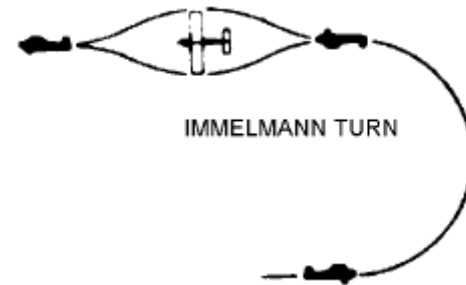
When calculating contestant scores, each individual maneuver score shall be multiplied by its K-factor. The flight score shall be the result of summing the "K-factored" (maneuver score multiplied by K-factor) scores.



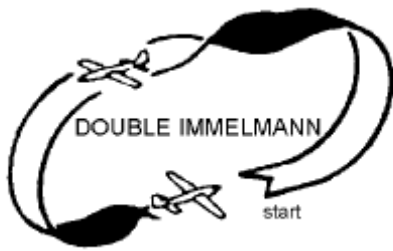
Make this is a two-point roll...
